Special Visitors' Weeks Information

Each year during Visitors' Weeks the classroom doors of The Raleigh School of Ballet are open to the family and guests of our students. This is a wonderful opportunity to see and hear what your child is learning and fully appreciate their progress. In addition, the faculty believes that during the winter months it energizes the dancers who also enjoy the opportunity to take class in front of an audience. At times some of our younger students may feel shy and not want to participate in class. This is very natural, and it is perfectly appropriate for them to observe class with you. No child should ever be forced to perform in front of an audience and generally these students feel more comfortable when they are a little older and have more experience.

This is an informal open house so younger siblings are welcome but we do request that they leave the classroom if they become a distraction for the dancers. Families are allowed to bring their cameras although flash photography is discouraged while the children are dancing since it may disorient them. If you are planning to photograph or video your child we request you are mindful of other families that may not want their child's picture or video posted on the internet. **We also request you turn off your cell phone before entering the classroom.**

- **Please car pool if you can. In addition to parking in our lot you may also park on Beryl Rd. between the railroad tracks and bus stop, in front of the old Ambiente Furniture building, Hand 2 Hand parking lot and the post office after 5:00 p.m. Please be mindful of No Parking Signs!**
- **During Visitors' Weeks January 31st - February 14th if you are not scheduled to observe classes, we request you drop your child off and leave the parking lot clear for guests.**
