### **Special Visitors' Weeks Information**

Each year during Visitors' Weeks the classroom doors of The Raleigh School of Ballet are open to the family and guests of our students. This is a wonderful opportunity to see and hear what your child is learning and fully appreciate their progress. In addition, the faculty believes that during the winter months it energizes the dancers who also enjoy the opportunity to take class in front of an audience. At times some of our younger students may feel shy and not want to participate in class. This is very natural, and it is perfectly appropriate for them to observe class with you. No child should ever be forced to perform in front of an audience and generally these students feel more comfortable when they are a little older and have more experience.

This is an informal open house so younger siblings are welcome but we do request that they leave the classroom if they become a distraction for the dancers taking the class. Families are allowed to bring their cameras although flash photography is not allowed during the class since it is disruptive and may disorient the dancers. If you are planning to photograph or video your child we request you are mindful of other families that may not want their child's picture or video posted on the internet. **We also request you turn off your cell phone before entering the classroom.**

**During Visitor Weeks the RSB parking lot tends to be more congested. We have come up with the following suggestions to help alleviate parking issues:**

- **Please car pool if you can. In addition to parking in our lot other options include:**
  - **On Beryl Rd. (opposite school) between the railroad tracks and bus stop, or from 3915 Beryl Rd. to Neomonde Deli on both sides of street**
  - **After 5:00 p.m.: Hand 2 Hand parking lot and the post office (front and back)**

- **During Visitors' Weeks February 3 - February 15<sup>th</sup> if you are not scheduled to observe classes, we request you drop your child off and leave the parking lot clear for guests.**
